NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

Introduction

The Village of Midlothian (Village) has received grant funding for green infrastructure from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). The Village is proposing a permeable parking lot on a gravel lot located south of the Village Hall on 14801 S. Pulaski Road. This green infrastructure Best Management Practices will improve water quality, remove pollutants prior to entering Midlothian Creek, enhance aesthetics of neighborhood, and heighten environmental awareness in the community.

Scope of Work

The Scope of Work as part of this Solicitation is for the installation of the Permeable Parking Lot **only**. The Permeable Parking Lot shall consist of a Permeable Articulating Concrete Blocks (PACB). The Village as part of the grant funding match will be performing the site preparation work for the parking lot including excavation to bottom of subbase, haul off, and erosion control measures. The Contractor will coordinate closely with the Village on the schedule of work so that installation of the parking lot will be as soon after site preparation work has been completed.

Bid Submission

Three (3) copies of the Bid Form are to be delivered no later than 10:00 A.M. on May 20, 2019 to:

Proposals will be publicly read aloud at 10:01 A.M. on May 20, 2019. No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the proposals without the consent of the Mayor and Board of Trustees for a period of forty-five days after the schedule time of closing.

All proposals shall be sealed in an envelope, addressed to the Village of Midlothian, attention Clerk's Office. The name and address of the bidder and the name of the project shall also appear on the outside of the envelope. Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by the Engineer.

The Bid Documents, including specifications, are on file at the Village of Midlothian, 14801 S. Pulaski Road, Midlothian, IL 60445. Bidders may schedule a time to pick up a hard copy or CD copy by emailing Allen Moskal at amoskal@villageofmidlothian.org. A payment for Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each paper copy and/or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per CD format is to be made to the Village. The Bid Documents will be issued until 5:00 P.M. on May 19, 2019. No refund will be made for documents received from the Village.

A certified check / bank draft drawn on a solvent bank, cashier's check or bid bond, payable without condition to the Village of Midlothian in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid shall be submitted with each proposal, as a guarantee that, if the proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of the contract is properly secured.

A performance bond in a sum equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid, with sureties to be approved by the Mayor and Board of Trustees for the faithful performance of the contract, must be furnished by the successful bidder. All bids or proposals shall contain an offer to furnish bond upon acceptance of such bid or proposal.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, to postpone the bid opening, or to advertise for new proposals, if in the judgment of the Mayor and board of Trustees their best interests will be promoted thereby. The Village also reserves the right to rescind any awarded contract if grant funding is no longer available to support this project.

The contractor will be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates on this project as established by the United States Department of Labor. He shall also comply with all applicable Federal, State, and local regulations.

Prequalification will be required to be submitted to the Village by all potential bidders. If in the opinion of the Mayor and Board of Trustees, an applicant would not be able to serve the best interest of the Village, a proposal will not be issued to the applicant.
