
Dear Midlothian Neighbors,

## Police Department

### Midlothian's New Police Station

In 2020, the Village Board approved the building of a new Police Station. The Board was able to do this without raising taxes by restructuring existing bonds.

After selecting an architect and construction manager for the project, the next step was to identify a suitable location for the facility. Four sites were evaluated, the only site that met our needs and allowed the project to be completed on budget was at Claire Blvd & Pulaski Road.

The new facility is projected to be finished in the summer of 2023. The Police Department is excited to move into the new station and looks forward to hosting community events for the residents.



MPD is excited to announce we have been awarded The Justice Department's Hiring Grant! This is HUGE! The Grant will cover the hiring of 3 fulltime officers for three years. This grant is expected to cover over half a million dollars over the next three years.

## STREETS & LAWN CARE

As the fall season is now upon us, please remember to clean up the leaves and clippings after maintaining your lawn and do not allow them to flow into the street or storm drains. Kindly dispose of your leaves and yard waste on your normal weekly refuse pick up day in a garbage can marked with a yard waste sticker, or a yard waste tote. Yard waste stickers are available at the Village Hall or the Public Works Department.

Public Works will continue to sweep the streets to keep up with falling leaves and debris. Street sweeping is a flood control measure to keep storm drains open and to allow rain to run into the sewers. When too many leaves accumulate in the street, they block storm sewers causing the streets to flood when it rains.

## Finance

### ARPA Funds

On March 11, 2021 the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law. This act is a funding effort to help local, county and state governments recover from the impacts of the Coronavirus pandemic. **The Village of Midlothian has received \$1,951,263.**

ARPA money can be used for a wide range of improvement projects such as water, sewer, and broadband projects. ARPA funds can also be used to offset revenue that the Village lost during the pandemic. The Village Board has created a list of projects that adheres to the guidelines set forth by the United States Treasury. The Board will update the residents as it decides how the ARPA funds will be used.

## Building Department

**YOUR HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE ARE OUR PRIMARY CONCERN!**

**Your home or business is an investment. Before starting an improvement project, please contact the Building Department and confirm if any proposed improvement requires a building permit.**

- A permit allows the Building Department to protect its residents and business owners by reducing the potential hazards of unsafe construction, while ensuring the public health,

safety and welfare.

- By following Village codes and ordinances, the completed project will meet minimum standards and will be less likely to cause injury to you, your family, your friends or future owners.
- Property insurers may not cover property damages caused by faulty construction completed without permits and inspections required by the Village.
- ALL contractors must be registered with the Village, and provide proof of business insurance. An updated registered contractor list is available through the Village Clerk and is on the Village's website.
- Check the contractor's references and reputation. Be cautious of "special deals". Remember – if it's too good to be true, it usually is!
- Get more than one quote, and always request a written estimate.
- Make sure the contract is completely filled out – no blank spaces. The contract should clearly state all work to be complete, timeframe for completion, total cost, guarantee timeframe, and who is responsible for guarantees.
- Do not sign 'completion papers' or a lien waiver or make final payment until all work has been completed to your satisfaction and has been inspected by the Building Department, if required.
