On behalf of the entire Village Board, I want to wish you and your family a happy healthy Holiday Season.



From The Board



At the November 16th Committee Meeting, Trustee Burbatt reported that the Village Board is investigating the possibility of eliminating the Village's minimum water usage for all residents. This change would reduce current water bills for over 600 residents and potentially save many more residents money on water bill

The Board will be voting on this in December!



ARPA - Funds (American Rescue Plan Act)

Trustee Crowley reported the Village has received approximately 1.9 million dollars in Federal ARPA Funds. A significant portion for these funds are earmarked for Water Infrastructure projects.

Police Department



The Midlothian Police Department would like residents to be aware of a recent rash of motor vehicle thefts involving primarily Kia and Hyundai brands nationwide. The years that are being targeted are 2010-2021 that need a physical key to start the vehicle (non-fob).

Thieves have been stealing the vehicles in all hours of the day from apartment complexes and parking lots and later using these vehicles in other crimes throughout the Chicagoland area.

- If parking in a driveway - use another vehicle to block it in
- Install a kill switch
- Purchase a steering wheel lock such as a Club
- Park in the garage
- Remove all valuables such as keys, fobs, garage door openers, electronics, firearms, and wallets/purses
- Please remember to report suspicious activity and dial 911 when needed.



Public Works is currently soliciting bids for a Spring/Summer 2023 Village-wide Fire Hydrant Painting project.



Snow, Streets & Plowing

With winter fast approaching we would like to remind our residents of the following issues pertaining to snow and its removal:

- Parking on Village streets is prohibited when 2 or more inches of snow is expected.
- Parked vehicles must be kept off of the streets for 24 hours after it has stopped snowing.

- When clearing your driveway, place snow on either side of the driveway or on the lawn, but never onto the street.
- **BE PATIENT.** Every storm is different, with many variables. Streets will most likely have to be plowed more than once.
- Midlothian Public Works is not responsible for State roads. IDOT is responsible for 147th Street and Cicero Avenue. Cook County handles Pulaski and Kedzie. The State and County each have their own personnel and equipment for snow removal.

Please adhere to our policies and procedures as outlined above to help expedite snow removal from Village streets, and to avoid having your vehicle ticketed and/or towed. Our main objective is to keep all streets completely accessible at all times, especially for emergency vehicles.

Fall/Winter Tips from the Building Department

- Residents should contact the Building Department to schedule final inspections to close out open permits. If projects cannot be completed until next spring due to the onset of cold weather, please contact the Building Department to make arrangements to extend the permit for any outdoor work such as driveways, fences, patios and site restoration.
- Clean and cover air conditioning condensers to prevent damage from ice formation in the coil.
- Have your furnace inspected by a qualified mechanical contractor to ensure proper functioning during the heating season.
- Make sure that chimney and furnace exhaust vent openings are not blocked by animal nests or other debris to prevent a backup of carbon monoxide into the house.
- Redirect downspout discharges if necessary to prevent slip/fall hazards due to icing of walkways and driveways.
- Clean gutters of leaves and other debris to provide proper drainage and help prevent ice damming of roof.
- Disconnect hoses from hose bibbs to prevent damage from freezing water
