This portion of work will take place through the spring and is expected to finish by the end of May.






Natalie Creek Update Oak Forest Senior Development

At the January 25, Board meeting, Village Engineer Huss reported:

I was able to get in touch with officials at Oak Forest who were very forthcoming. If there are follow up questions after the information below, I am sure they address them.

- Oak Forest has received the preliminary plan (same one we have seen) and given *in-concept* approval for the site's intended use.
- Developer is still performing further studies/due diligence on the property.
- Oak Forest is not aware if the Developer has even closed on the property.
- No final site engineering plans have been submitted to Oak Forest.
- Oak Forest has a similar process to Midlothian, whereas they perform an internal review before authorizing the developer to submit to MWRD.

I requested a copy of their formal plans when they become available and will continue to follow up with Oak Forest for updates.


Hometown Hero's Banner

Winter Weather and Plumbing

Prevent freezing pipes this winter especially during extreme cold snaps by letting a small trickle of water run at a kitchen or bathroom sink. Also check to make sure that pipes near exterior walls in a basement or crawl space are protected from drafts.

Here are some helpful tips:

1. Turn off outside water valves to prevent frozen pipes.
2. Know the location of your home's main water valve.
3. Conserve your home's energy – but don't go too low!
4. Make sure your water heater runs properly.
5. Don't clog kitchen drains and be careful with the disposal.
6. Prepare outside drainage.

SAFETY TIP OF THE DAY

Space Heater Safety Tips

- Keep space heaters a minimum of three feet from combustible materials such as draperies, furniture fabric or carpeting.
- Never leave a space heater unattended, particularly in the presence of children or pets. Not only is there potential for burn injuries, but some heaters are easily knocked over which may cause a fire hazard.
- Always plug a space heater directly into a wall outlet. Extension cords may not be rated for the electric amperage required by the heater.
- Do not use damaged space heaters. Check for broken or bent grilles, and cuts, abrasions, or exposed wires in the power cord.
- Make sure the space heater is placed on a level surface.
- Do not use portable space heaters with open flames indoors.


